Paying Tuition Online

Bus Rules for Safety



1. Be at the bus stop 5 minutes early.
2. Respect the bus driver and listen to instructions.
3. Take your seat right away after boarding the bus.
4. Stay seated at all times.
5. Always get on and off the bus at your bus stop.
6. Get off the bus carefully, using the handrail.
7. Keep your head, arms, legs and hands inside the bus.
8. Before crossing the road, to get to the bus, be sure to wait for the bus driver's signal to cross over to the bus.
9. Wait for the bus 10 feet off the road or on the sidewalk.
10. Keep away from the bus if you drop or forget something.

Bus Information

1. Please review bus numbers with your child. In addition, it is a good idea to have younger students wear or carry some form of identification with the child's name, address and telephone number, as well as the bus number(s). This will assist teachers and drivers in making sure each child gets on the correct bus at the end of the day. It will also help drivers get a child home if the child boards the wrong bus.
2. Remind children about safety on and around buses. Classroom behavior is expected on the bus, but talking in a normal speaking voice is allowed. Students should understand that drivers need to concentrate on driving in order to get everyone to their destinations safely and on time.
3. It is a good idea to provide a book bag or backpack for younger children to carry artwork and papers home from school. Placing these items inside a book bag reduces the chance that a child will drop a piece of paper as he or she gets off the bus. Though school bus tragedies are rare, too often they occur as a child tries to retrieve an object that has fallen under the bus. Also, make sure book bags and backpacks do not have straps or other dangling items that can get caught in bus doors.
4. Our school buses make hundreds of stops each day. During the first few days of school, students may occasionally not be picked up at their bus stops, or there may be a delay in getting children home.

SCRIP

SCRIP Program Sign up with the Raise Right App or at raiseright.com, enrollment code #6898L53F1727L to place orders to ship to your house, use electronically, reload physical gift cards, or ship to the school. You may also place manual orders using the blue sheets next to the SCRIP box in the narthex, or purchase from the select amount of gift cards we keep on hand in the school office. Woodman's gift cards are only available in the office. Manual ordering instructions are on the bulletin board above the SCRIP box. You will receive **5%** tuition credit for the total dollar amount of your orders. School orders are placed a couple times a month on the Monday dates listed below, to arrive the following Friday. To place an order outside of this time, you can purchase from what is available in the office, select gift cards through the App to ship to your home for a small shipping fee, add money to reloadable physical gift cards, or use electronic gift cards through the App. Questions or issues can be directed to Jessica at 715-416-1391.
