Thank you for choosing Christ Lutheran School, which is responsible for educating your child. We are thankful for each of our students.

February 1st begins our enrollment period for the 2025/2026 school year. We are looking forward to continuing our commitment to provide an excellent education for your child in the coming year.

Tuition rates for the 2025/2026 school year have been set and approved. Our goal is to keep tuition increases as reasonable as possible. We work to balance the financial demands on our families to provide a quality education for your children. The school board voted to raise the tuition costs for the coming year, focusing on raising teacher salaries by a conservative amount and helping us meet the budget with a smaller enrollment. We are blessed at Christ Lutheran School with a fantastic staff, and we would like to retain the staff and pay them a fair salary considering inflation rates as well.

The tuition increase for this coming school year is between \$22-\$42 per month per child. This increase was voted on and approved by the school board to continue to support our valuable teaching staff.

Please refer to the tuition rate sheet for tuition costs for the coming school year. As enrollment opens on February 1st, please visit the school website at <u>https://www.christlutheranschool.org/admissions</u> to enroll your child for the 2025/2026 school year. Scroll down and click on "application" when registering. Current students enrolled at CLS get first placement if forms have been filled out online by March 1st. There are a limited number of students accepted in each class.
